Item 1 – One author

- Regular, consistent sleep is linked to better grades in high school students (Lee).
 Parenthetical
- Lee found that regular, consistent sleep is linked to better grades in high school students. - Narrative

Key features: last name only in the citation; no year; no comma before any page number if one were included.

Item 2 - Two authors

- Smith and Patel argue that daily reading supports vocabulary development in middle school students. - Narrative
- Scientists argue that daily reading supports vocabulary development in middle school students (Smith and Patel). - Parenthetical

Key features: both authors' last names connected with "and"; no year; no comma before any page number if added.

Item 3 – Three or more authors

- Working on group projects can help students develop stronger collaboration skills (Green et al.). - Parenthetical
- Green et al. report that working on group projects can help students develop stronger collaboration skills. - Narrative

Key features: first author's last name + "et al." for three or more authors; no year in MLA intext citations.
