

MANGA ARE JAPANESE COMIC BOOKS. THE ART IN MANGA IS UNIQUE, AND EASY TO TELL APART FROM WESTERN COMICS SUCH AS MARVEL AND DC. MANGA TENDS TO UTILIZE A BLACK AND WHITE COLOUR SCHEME, AND MORE OR LESS SIMILAR CHARACTERS WITH BIG, BRIGHT, EYES. IN ANY FORM OF ART, ARTISTIC STYLE TENDS TO CHANGE WITH THE AUTHOR.



MANGA AS WE KNOW IT NOW BEGAN IN THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY. THIS WAS WHEN JAPANESE ARTISTS BEGAN TO MERGE IDEAS FROM WESTERN COUNTRIES WITH THEIR OWN. WITH THE STRANGE NEW IDEAS THAT CAME FROM THE WEST, AND THE FAST INCREASING DEVELOPMENTS IN JAPANESE SOCIETY, MANGA BEGAN THIS NEW ERA.

FROM THE 1990'S AND ON, MANGA HAD ITS BIG DEBUT, BECOMING WILDLY POPULAR IN THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA.

WRONG WAY!

Japanese books, including manga like this one, are meant to be read from right to left.

So the front cover is actually the back cover, and vice-versa.

To read this book, please flip it over and start in the top right-hand corner. Read the panels, and the bubbles in the panels, from right to left, then drop down to the next row and repeat.

It may make you dizzy at first, but forcing your brain to do things backwards makes you smarter in the long run. We swear.


START FROM THE BACK

Go to the other end of the book and start at page 1. Your mother and I are very disappointed in you.



OPTION 1: Follow the balloons from left to right and top to bottom then move on to the


next panel. the way you learned it at that sissy school of yours.

A style of manga which usually targets young males. They are typically full of fighting and action.


Some examples of these are Naruto, One Piece, Death Note, Fullmetal Alchemist, and Dragonball Z

SCHOOL LIFE

A GENRE SIMILAR TO SLICE OF LIFE. SCHOOL LIFE IS PREDOMINANTLY BASED AROUND THE LIFE OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS. IT TARGETS HIGH SCHOOL AGE READERS WITH REALISTIC SCENARIOS AND RELATABLE CONFLICTS. SERIES IN THIS CATEGORY OFTEN OVERLAP WITH GENRES LIKE SHOUJO AND SLICE OF LIFE.
